ADOPTION AGREEMENT

This Adoption Agreement is entered into on the date set forth below between Lisa Parker's Puppies (LPP) and _____ (Adopter). The Adoption Application provided by Adopter is incorporated herein and is made part of this Adoption Agreement. In consideration of the \$275.00 non-refundable non-transferable adoption donation provided to LPP by Adopter and the representations made by Adopter to LPP, LPP agrees to adopt out the LPP dog described below from LPP to Adopter, pursuant to the following terms and conditions.

Neutering/Spaying: If not altered at the time of adoption, your LPP dog must be spayed or neutered at the date requested by LPP and must not be used for breeding purposes prior to that time. LPP will collect a \$100 altering deposit at the time of adoption to be returned to the adopter upon proof of spay or neuter. Adopter must provide LPP with written confirmation from the veterinarian who performed the procedure within seven (7) days of the completion of the procedure. If Adopter does not provide LPP with proof of spay/neuter as required herein, LPP may, in its sole discretion, terminate the adoption and retake possession of the LPP dog, with no refund of the \$275.00 adoption donation or the \$100.00 altering deposit.

LPP may provide assistance with the spay/neuter procedure if Adopter requests same from LPP. If LPP provides assistance with the spay/neuter, it will be through a voucher system with Aspentree Animal Caring Center of Durango.

Health and Welfare of LPP Dog: The health and welfare of LPP dogs is of primary importance to LPP. Your LPP dog's optimum health must be maintained through the feeding of quality dog food, maintenance of proper weight for dog's build, adequate water, daily exercise, shelter, and annual exams and vaccinations by a licensed veterinarian. No LPP dog shall be transported in the open bed in the back of a truck. No LPP dog shall be tethered to a tie out at any time. If any health conditions or medical concerns arise within the first ten (10) days after adoption, Adopter will contact LPP. LPP may, in its sole discretion, provide or assist with vet care, but such vet care must be provided by Aspentree Animal Caring Center of Durango. If Adopter chooses to seek vet care from a provider other than Aspentree Animal Caring Center of Durango, LPP will not be responsible for any charges incurred.

Identification: Your LPP dog must wear identification at all times attached securely to nylon or leather collar or harness. Your LPP dog must be licensed and tagged in accordance with local laws and wear personal identification as well. LPP will microchip prior to adoption.

Training: Your LPP dog is a family member / companion. Your LPP dog may never be protection or attack trained or used as a guard dog for any agency, firm, corporation or organization. Your LPP dog shall not wear a choke chain at any time. Your LPP dog must not be merely an outdoor yard dog, but
